#### **PC/24/157 – Lovedon Fields – Update on meeting with the Management company and agreement of access arrangements**

Cllr Cossburn updated members on the site meeting held that afternoon.

A number of items were discussed, and we are waiting from a confirmation email from the management company for us to review and allow them to send to their residents. They anticipate they should receive an answer from residents in approximately one week.

The Recreation & Amenities Committee will review an updated allotment tenancy agreement next week's meeting.

Councillors discussed the provision of speed signage at the entrance to Eversley Gardens, and both additional ongoing and initial grounds maintenance works.

To ensure work progresses as soon as possible, it was unanimously agreed to give Recreation & Amenities Committee a budget of £2,000.00 for the initial site preparation works, and a £1,000.00 budget for the speed signage and associated street furniture.

Costs will also be obtained for the preparation and sowing of wildflower seed on the bank behind the allotment.
