Yew tree – reduce by 2m restorative pruning and shaping to maintain.

P/24/111 – Matters arising from the meeting held on 22 October 2024

P/24/112 – Planning & Highways dashboards; include planning decisions advised since the last meeting and enforcement notices.

Cllr Cossburn gave an update to members.

P/24/113 – Available Updated (if any)

- Ecogen application/liaison panel – HGV reporting signs are being installed in the three bus shelters on Lovedon Lane and to numerous road sign standards along Lovedon Lane. Installation will be completed by 22/11/2024
- Progress of repairs to listed wall in Abbots Worthy – No update.
- Speed sign deployment – including data, deployment and potential reduction of the speed limit in Abbots Worthy –
 - F&R have given approval for the purchase of a second device with three caveats.
 - The need for the second sign to show a different visual to the original device had already been addressed in the revised license document.
 - A system is required to report over speeding to the Police for action.
 - Confirmation that the Springvale Road cannot legally be fitted with 30mph repeater signs.

After discussion it was decided that the second device should show the recorded speed with the message “Slow Down” when over-speed was detected.

Actions: Clerk to re-apply for revised licence and circulate details of the Police reporting system created when the original device was purchased to members of P&H for review. Second device to be ordered (Cllr Cossburn to confirm required type with Clerk) Cllr Cossburn to provide the information regarding repeater signs.

P/24/114 – Speed Enforcement

P/24/115– Ridge & Partners Cooperation including potential solutions for

parking issues and various footpaths.

Ridge have confirmed that engineering solutions have been formulated and will shortly be reviewed by the Quantity Surveying Team to provide budget costings for budgeting purposes.

P/24/116 – Electric vehicle charger

As Cllr Horne reported that currently no grant funding was available but that he would continue to monitor for schemes offering grant funding.

Members discussed the topics for the next newsletter and decided to include the following:
