P/12/137 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Denis Welstead who was ill.

P/12/138 Public Question Time

There were no members of the public present.

P/12/139 Minutes of the Meeting held on the 30 October 2012

The minutes were agreed as a true record of the meeting and were signed by Cllr Gordon.

P/12/140 Matters Arising from the Meeting of the 30 October 2012

- P/12/127 Hookpit Farm Lane it was reported that the planning application had been approved by WCC. Cllrs White and Reiners have met with Stuart Dunbar-Dempsey (WCC) and it was reported that the Parish Council had previously agreed to take on the strip of amenity land, although there was no written record of this.
- P/12/127 Tesco Garages notices have now been served by WCC enforcement officers and it is now necessary to await responses.
- P/12/127 Hilltop the planning application was approved by Winchester City Council.
- P/12/127 Parking on Verges this is getting worse and damage is increasing because of the wet weather.

 P/12/127 Street Lighting – HCC have confirmed that the street lighting replacement work within the village will commence in February 2014. It was noted that the contract for street light repairs contains the following response requirements:

a) Emergenciesb) Urgent2 hours24 hours

c) Non-emergency 3 business days

Rectification periods which include cable faults are not subject to the above requirements.

- P/12/127 Oakland's, Stoke Charity Road Cllr Gordon to write to Simon Finch, head of WCC's Planning Department, to obtain conformation that no planning legislation had been breached. Action – Cllr Gordon
- P/12/132 Sewerage Issues in North Road area Southern Water are now investigating the problems of sewerage flooding gardens and alleyways on a "monthly" basis.

The dashboard is attached as part of the minutes of the meeting. It listed the following items;

- Major Initiatives Requiring PC Approval
 - Street Lighting the invoice for April September has been received at £3,055.36 representing a significant saving against the £4,000 budget for the same period.
 - Lit Speed Limit Sign the additional post for Abbotts Worthy has not been pursued yet, as the Police have been asked to put a radar trap in place in Abbots Worthy instead. This could be linked with the introduction of Speedwatch within the village and this is being investigated by Cllr Gordon. Action – Cllr Gordon

P/12/143 Proposed Worthy Down Development

The parish office has been given a full set of the papers for this application to be available to members of the public as part of the consultation exercise. The plans were examined and were considered as not impacting on the parish as the major developments were outside the parish boundaries. It had been stated that South Wonston Primary School has sufficient capacity to accommodate the anticipated rise in the number of primary school age children.

P/12/144 Kings Worthy Primary School extension

It was proposed to build three classrooms, a store room and a possible welfare room to replace the two temporary classrooms currently on site. HCC will be looking at the associated parking issues. Concern was raised as to whether or not theses proposals would provide sufficient future capacity against the requirement for Kings Worthy to provide up to an extra 250 homes over the next 20 years. It was agreed that Cllr Gordon would write to HCC to express these concerns. **Action – Cllr Gordon**
